

Manningham City Council is proposing to upgrade Aranga Reserve, Donvale to provide a focus for dog activities. This proposal includes opportunities for training and educational activities, and physical and social activities for pet owners and their families.

Proposed Dog Activity Centre Works

- 1.5m dog proof fence for a puppy training area and a larger general activity area
- Use of the vacant Panoramic Heights Pre-School building for FOMDAC
- Dogs drinking fountain and bowls
- Signage / notice board
- Agility equipment
- Double gated entry point
- Dog tidy container / two bins
- Eight additional car parking spaces

A series of general improvement works to the reserve is included in the proposal.

General Improvements to the Reserve

- Play Space Upgrade including provision of seating, shade planting and buffer planting
- Maintenance of links between Aranga Crescent to Donvale Primary School and pedestrian access between Eastway Avenue & Aranga Crescent
- Additional Car Parking at eastern boundary
- Improved access and landscaping at the Aranga Crescent entrance to the Reserve

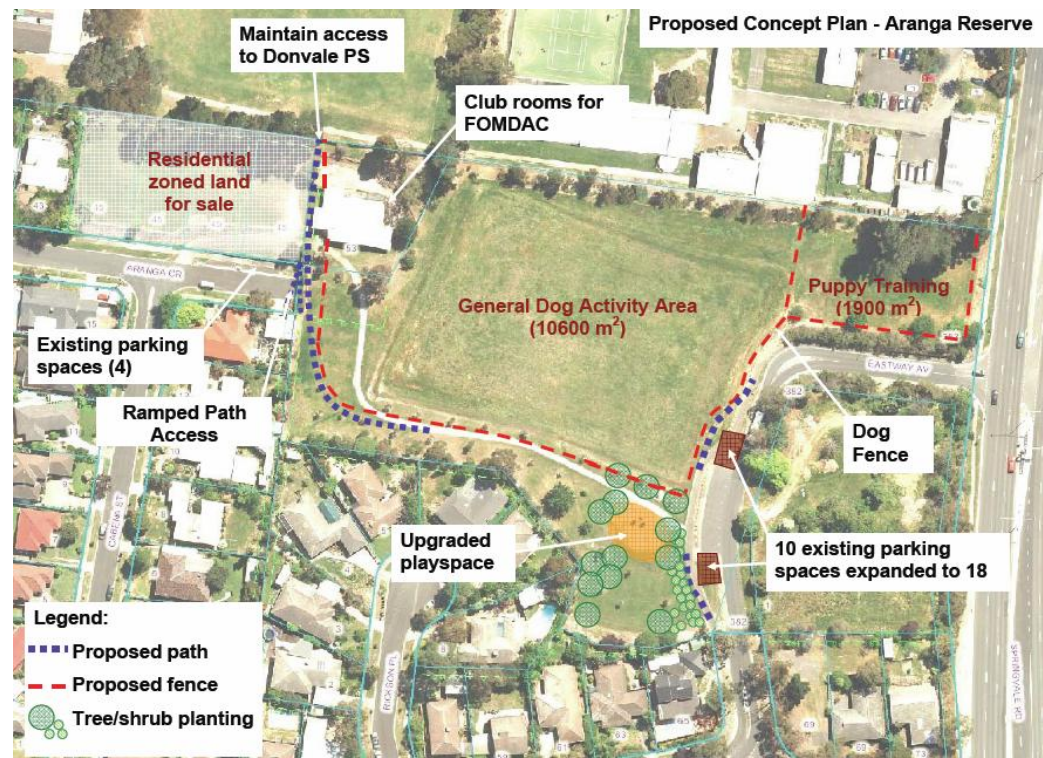
